MUNSON BANK

In the early 1900's this building housed the Traders' Bank in Munson, Alberta, which merged with The Royal Bank of Canada in 1912, At that time the Town of Munson was the business centre of the Drumheller Valley, however in later years lack of water and several disastrous fires virtually wiped out the town.

During the early days of this century — when this bank was new — all the bank clerks were young men. They wore shades to protect their eyes from the glare of the Coleman Lamps and stood at high desks or perched on tall stools to work.

Generally the life of the bank clerks in a small town was very pleasant. Many bank clerks augmented their income by teaching music or playing baseball or hockey. The "bank boys", as the town's most popular bachelors, were usually in the centre of the community's social life as well.

This building was moved to Heritage Park and restored as an historical example of a bank in the "Old Days". It was officially "opened" on this site June 25th, 1966.

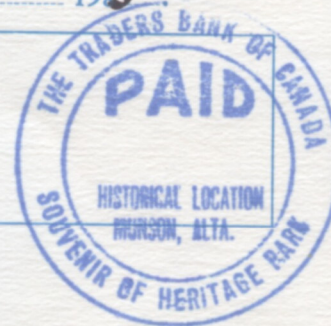

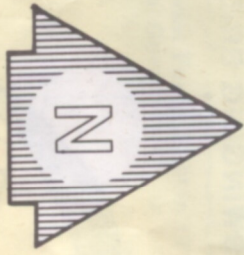

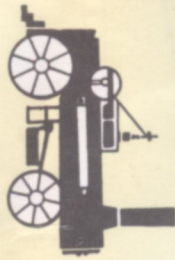

Homestead (Antique) Museum: Here, hundreds of antique items from the old west are on display.



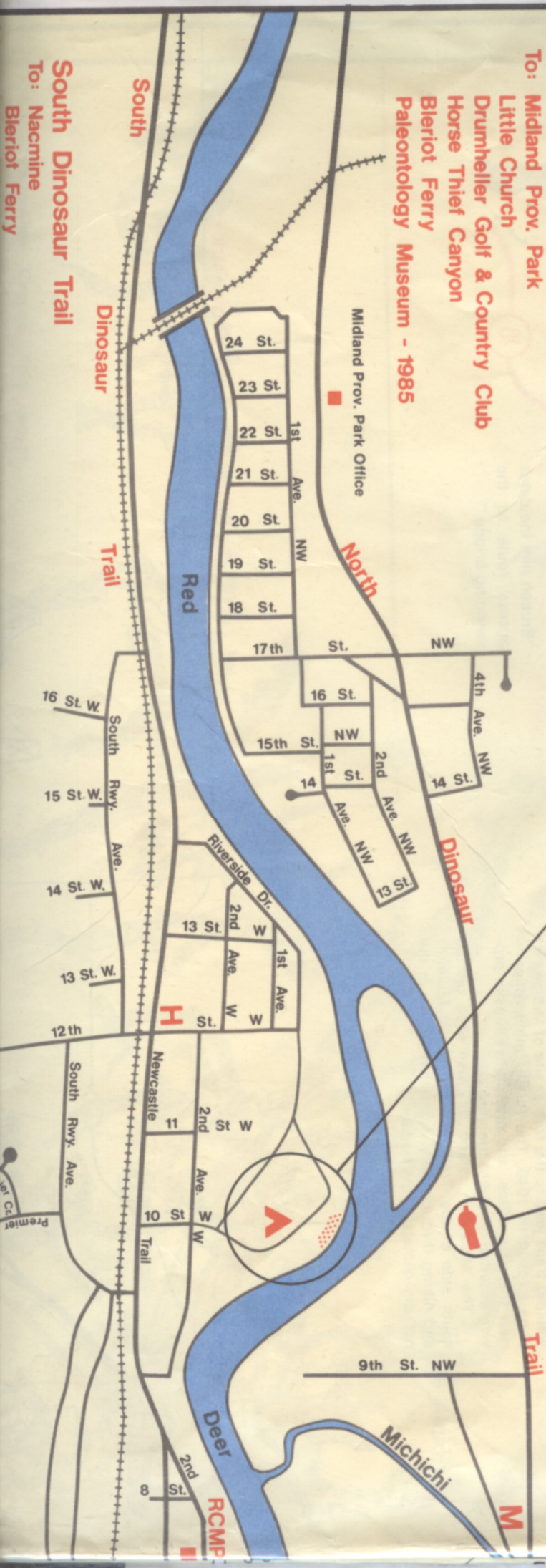
